How Peoples Community Health Clinic Determines Your Sliding Fee Category

A patient's Sliding Fee Category is based on the number of people in their household and their total annual income, using the chart below.

When calculating a patient's income, PCHC considers the following sources:

Federal Poverty Guidelines (updated yearly)

If PCHC has not already assigned you to a Sliding Fee Category, or if your household income has recently changed, you must bring the following documents with you to your appointment: If you forget to bring these documents to your appointment, PCHC will be unable to determine your sliding fee category.

- Wages Most recent paystubs (2 most recent)
- Unemployment Award letter or 2 most recent bank statements
- Self-Employment Most recent federal tax return
- Social Security/Disability award letter or 2 most recent bank statements
- Financial Assistance Application

Once you know your Sliding Fee Category and the services you should expect to receive, you can figure out how much you should expect to pay. Here's an example:

A patient comes in for a regular medical visit. He has 4 people in his household, and PCHC counts his total income as \$47,000. Using the chart above, he is in Sliding Fee Category "C".

As the patient is in Sliding Fee Category C, the charge for the medical visit is \$20.
